Trained 600+ youth and women on climate-smart agriculture and renewable energy adoption.



Supported 10+ local organizations (WRUAs, CFAs, CBOs) in developing natural resource management plans.



Initiated restorative value chains in beekeeping, fruit processing, and fodder enterprises.
